

Virginia Petition for the Removal of an Officer

Petition Signer Statement We, the qualified voters of Fairfax County, Virginia (Providence District) signed hereunder or on the reverse side of this page do hereby

 petition the circuit court to order the removal of Karl Frisch, from the office of School Board Member,
(OFFICER'S NAME) (OFFICE TITLE)

pursuant to §24.2-233 of the Code of Virginia. The specific reasons or grounds upon which the above official is sought to be removed, are as follows: Mr. Karl Frisch retained incumbency in November 2023 as Chair for the FCPS School Board. He took his oath with a display of mockery against parents by using books containing sexually graphic material for his swearing-in ceremony. One book titled, "Gender Queer," includes material that Federal law defines as "visual representation of obscene matter to minors, which can include cartoons that depict minors engaged in sexual activity," and prohibits that, "any person who, in a circumstance described in subsection (d), knowingly produces, distributes, receives, or possesses with intent to distribute, a visual depiction of any kind, including a drawing, cartoon." Mr. Frisch's actions represent clear neglect of ministerial duty of the office, misuse of the office, and incompetence in the performance of the duties of the office. Mr. Karl Frisch's actions clearly ignore Virginia Department of Education Code of Ethics, including the oath of office defined in Virginia Code Title 49.

Your signature will enact a removal process to begin with the Fairfax County Circuit Court. A call to immediately suspend Karl Frisch from the Office of School Board Member upon filing of this petition, as permitted by Virginia Code 24.2-236, and subsequently set a trial for his removal.

Other applicable Virginia Code statutes and Federal laws:
 -- Virginia Code 24.2-233: "Upon petition, a circuit court may remove from office any elected officer or officer who has been appointed to fill an elective office, residing within the jurisdiction of court ... [f]or neglect of a clear, ministerial duty of the office, misuse of the office, or incompetence in the performance of duties has a material adverse effect upon the conduct of the office."
 -- Title 18, Section 1466A of the United States Code prohibits any person from knowingly producing receiving, or possessing with the intent to distribute "a visual depiction of any kind, including a a drawing [or] cartoon ... that ... depicts a minor engaging in sexually explicit conduct."

The Circulator Affidavit must be completed and signed in front of the Notary.• The petition signatures must equal 10% of the total number of votes cast at the last election for the office the officer holds.
